Mr. Albert Grady “ Al” Cason, Jr., 72, passed away on March 26, 2026. A Celebration of Life Service will be held on Thursday, April 2, 2026 at 3 PM in the Chapel of Williams Funeral Home in Milledgeville. Inurnment will be private at a later date.

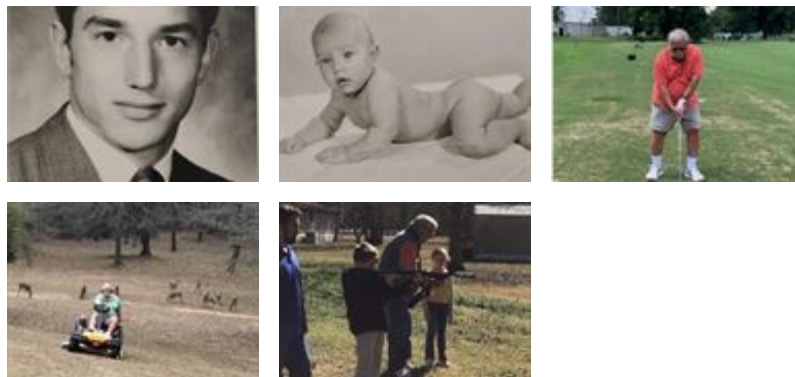
