



Alan "Al" Lynn Kobbe

August 15, 1945 - May 4, 2014

Mr. Alan Lynn Kobbe age 68 of Milledgeville, Georgia passed away Sunday, May 4, 2014.

Mr. Kobbe was a native of Forksville, PA and had made his home in Milledgeville since 1981.

He was predeceased by his parents Francis Ralph Kobbe and Beltha Boyles Kobbe along with two brothers Delos and Durwood Kobbe.

Prior to moving to Milledgeville, Georgia, Mr. Kobbe worked for 16 years for North Penn Gas Company, where he received early retirement. He was also elected as city councilman just prior to leaving his home in Mansfield, Pennsylvania in order to co-own and operate the Goodie Gallery which was the former Plow Boy Drive Inn. After selling the Goodie Gallery he then joined the Bi Lo Grocery Store. Later he became the Custodial Supervisor of Georgia College and State University from where he retired.

Mr. Kobbe was an army veteran and member of the Friendship Lodge No. 247 in Williamsport, PA, a 32nd degree Mason and Past Master of the No. 247 Lodge. He was also a member of the First Christian Church of Milledgeville.

Survivors include his wife Beverly Metcalf Kobbe of Milledgeville, son Eric Scot (Ashley) Kobbe of Milledgeville, and two granddaughters, Kinsey Brooke Kobbe and Kristan Anna Kobbe. He also has one brother, Norman Kobbe of Montgomery, Pa.

Funeral Services for Mr. Alan Kobbe will be conducted Wednesday at 2 pm in Williams Funeral Home Chapel. The family will receive friends Wednesday from 1 pm until the service hour at Williams Funeral Home in Milledgeville.

Interment and other services will be conducted Saturday at Kenyon Funeral Home in Westfield, Pa. at 2:00 pm.

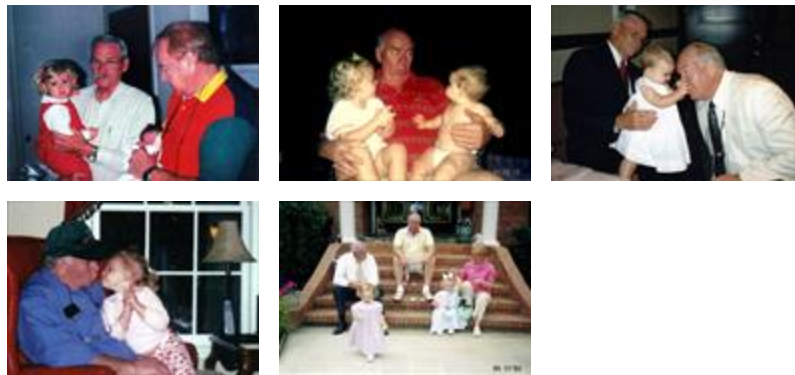
