Alan Milton Womack, age 60, of Milledgeville, passed away Monday, June 17, 2024. A Celebration of Life for Alan Womack will be conducted Saturday, June 22, 2024 at 2:00 PM in the Milledgeville First Methodist Church with Rev. Mac Enfinger officiating. The family will receive friends at the church on Saturday, June 22, 2024 from 1:00 PM until the service hour.

A native of El Paso, TX, Alan was born on November 10, 1963 to the late William M. Womack, Jr. and Linda Tallant Womack Daniels. Alan grew up in Dunwoody, and later moved to Cumming, GA.
