February 9, 1942 - June 25, 2024

Mack “Arthur” Calhoun, age 82, of Milledgeville, passed away Tuesday, June 25, 2024. Funeral services for Arthur Calhoun will be conducted Saturday, June 29, 2024 at 11:00 AM in Northridge Christian Church with Rev. Bill King and Rev. Larry Glover officiating. Interment will be in Heritage Memorial Park. The family will receive friends at the Northridge Christian Church on Saturday, June 29, 2024 from 9:30AM until the service hour.

A native of Arlington, GA, Arthur was born on February 9, 1942 to the late Edwin “Buck” Calhoun and the late Katie Miller Calhoun. Along with his parents, he was also preceded in death by a son, Derrick Calhoun, and by a granddaughter, Monica Leggett. Arthur came to Milledgeville, working for Piggly Wiggly. He purchased a battery franchise in 1966. The franchise became Calhoun Battery, Inc., one of the largest independent battery dealers in the Southeastern United States. Arthur was a member of Community Baptist Church.

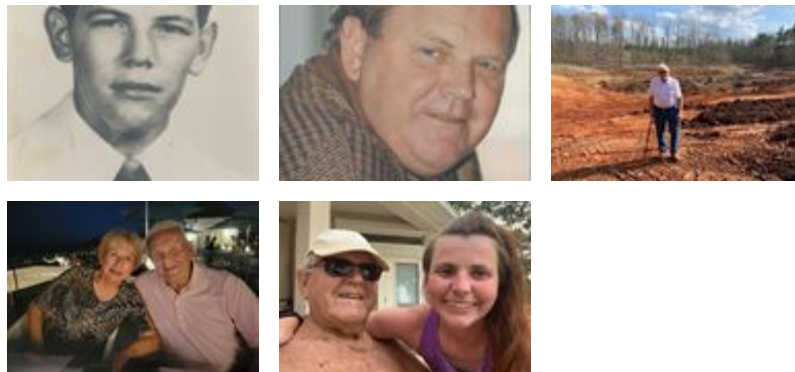
