June 6, 1938 - February 1, 2026

Barbara Klix Allen, born June 6, 1938, aged 87, passed away on February 1, 2026 in Athens, Ga after a brief illness. Barbara was born in Tacoma Park, Maryland, the second of five children and oldest daughter. She enjoyed life and all the challenges that came with being a mother of seven very active children and a full-time worker. Barbara was all about family and celebrating family. Her house became the meeting place at Thanksgiving for all her siblings, nephews, nieces, children, and “extended family”. 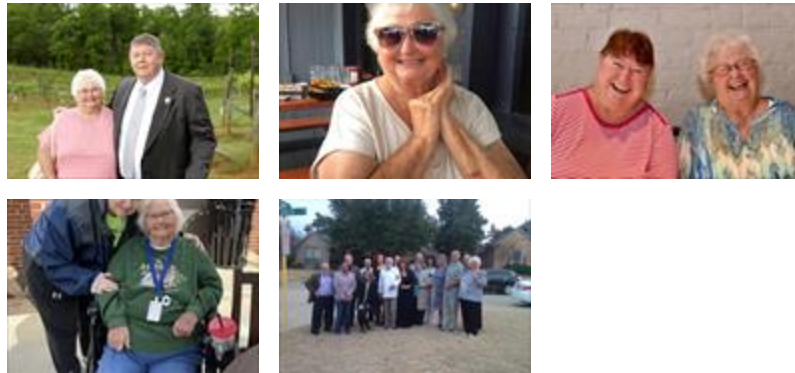
