Barbara Thomas Giles Mauldin “Tut”, 77, passed away on March 5, 2022. A Funeral Service will be held on Wednesday, March 9, 2022 at 2PM in the Williams Funeral Home Chapel in Milledgeville. 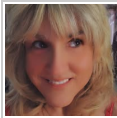

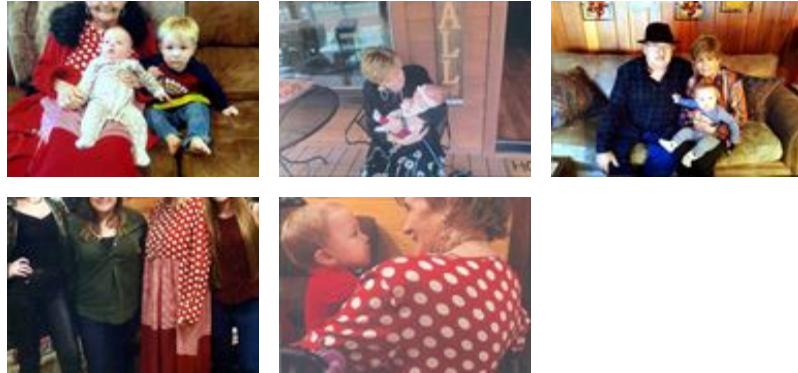
