Benton Bryant, 80, of Gordon, passed away Friday, August 29, 2008, in Macon. Son of the late William and Myrtle Birdsong Bryant, born in Twiggs County, he lived in Wilkinson County for most of his adult life. Mr. Bryant began his career by making seat covers for automobiles in Macon, he met Frank Massengale & Nat Bacon, in 1954 he went to Milledgeville where he opened & managed a body shop for Bacon Chevrolet for 21 years. He built a new building on Hwy 18 in Gordon in 1975 and opened Bryant Body Shop & Wrecker Service. Mr. Bryant finally closed his business and built a garage at his home where he began to rebuild automobiles. He later opened Bryant's Trucking Co. & he & Doug Tisdell traveled all over the U.S. selling auto parts & plane parts. Preceded in death by his sister, Billie Bryant Allen, he was a member of Liberty Hill United Methodist Church.
