



## Betty Register Oxford Walton

March 23, 1933 - June 29, 2014

Funeral services for Mrs. Betty Register Oxford Walton will be conducted 2 pm Thursday, July 3, 2014 in the New Hope Worship Center with Rev. Beverly McLaren and Rev. Danny Herron officiating. Interment will be private.

Mrs. Betty Faye Register Oxford Walton age 81 passed away Sunday, June 29, 2014. She was a native of Laurens county and had made her home in Milledgeville for most of her life moving to Candler N.C. two years ago. She was retired from Forstman and Co. formerly J.P. Stevens and was a member of New Hope Worship Center in Milledgeville, but more recently attended Harvest Time Assembly in Asheville, N.C.

She was predeceased by her parents Stewart Lester Register and Lillie Bell Guy Register, siblings Cullen Register, Geralton Register and Dellery Register Ballew and was the widow of the late Andrew L. "Pete" Oxford and Cline Walton.
