William Pierce “Bill” Stevens, age 95, of Milledgeville, passed away Sunday, April 26, 2026. 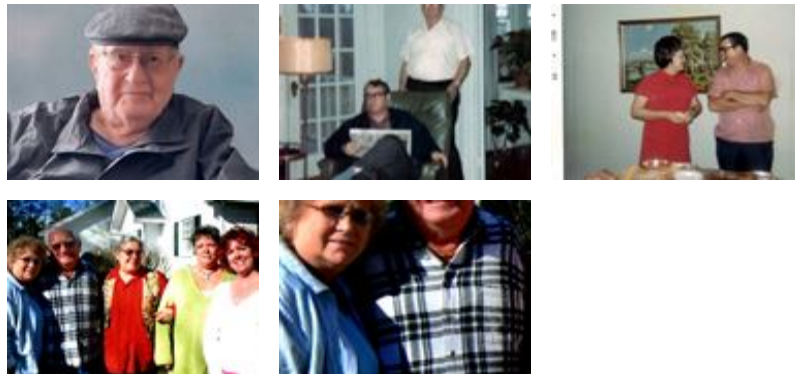
