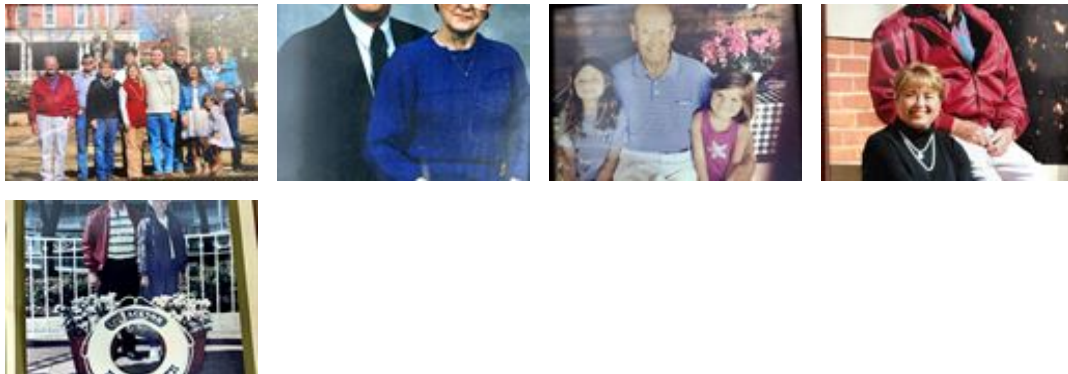
“ To the Wall Family,
