Funeral services for Mr. Billy Dwain Longino, age 84, will be conducted Thursday at 6pm at Williams Funeral Home Chapel in Milledgeville. Rev. Mac Enfinger will be officiating.

Billy was born and raised in Cordele, GA. He attended college for two years in Americus, GA at Georgia Southwestern. He transferred to the University of Georgia, where he received his BBA (Bachelors of Business Administration) with a Major in Accounting and a Minor in Finance. He furthered his education by receiving a MACC (Master of Accountancy) at UGA. He was an avid UGA fan! He met the love of his life, Dixie, in Cordele, GA, and they married in Funston, GA on December 18, 1966. They shared 51 devoted years of marriage together. They had three precious children, Michael and Mitch, both born in Cordele, and Candice, born in Athens. Billy and his family moved from Athens in 1974 to Perry, GA where he worked as an accountant at a textile company named Kellwood Incorporated. In 1982, the family moved to Milledgeville, GA. Billy worked as an accountant in Sandersville, GA at GA Kaolin from 1982 until 1995. In November of 1995, he transitioned to the Milledgeville Board of Education. He served as the Finance Director for the Baldwin County School System until December 31, 2005, when he retired.

In addition to his work career, Billy was a faithful husband, providing father, loving grandfather, and sweet friend to many who knew and loved him.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Dixie Lee Weger Longino; father, Robert Francis Longino; mother, Maggie Viola Rittenberry Carter Longino; and his sister, Frances Garrett.

He is survived by his sons, Michael Longino of Atlanta; Mitch (Pam) Longino of Milledgeville; daughter, Candice (Jeb) Massie of Valdosta; grandchildren, Miles (Alyxandrea) and Aaron Longino; Callee and John Massie; brother, Randy Longino of Kansas; sister-in-law, Diana Weger of Quitman; and many other loving family members and precious friends.

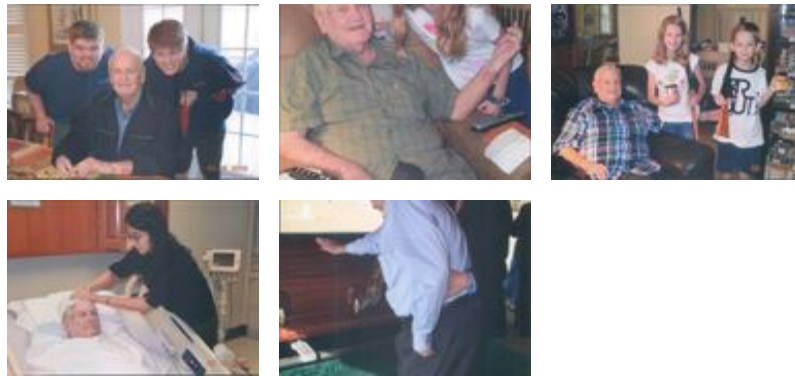
