

Rev. Billy Carroll Mixon

October 5, 1935 - November 20, 2022

Rev. Billy Carroll Mixon, age 87, of Milledgeville, passed away Sunday, November 20, 2022. Funeral services for Rev. Billy Mixon will be conducted Wednesday, November 23, 2022 at 11:00 AM in the Chapel of Williams Funeral Home with Rev. Brent Wooten officiating. Interment will follow in Heritage Memorial Park. The family will receive friends at the Williams Funeral Home on Wednesday, November 23, 2022 from 10:00 AM until the service hour.

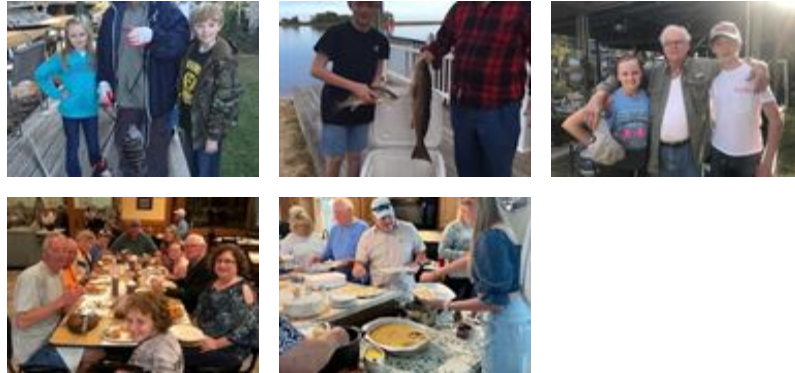
