He was retired from the Georgia Department of Natural Resources as Lt. Colonel and he had spent most of his career on the Georgia Coast from 1974 to 1997.

He was a Graduate of Georgia College and also served on the Baldwin County Board of Registrars,

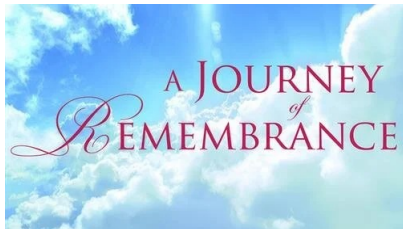

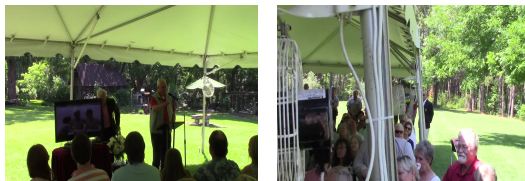
