Mrs. Brenda Tollison Mason, 75, passed away on Saturday, September 8, 2018. Funeral services will be held on Tuesday, September 11th at 3pm at First United Methodist Church in Milledgeville. The family will receive friends beginning at 1pm until the service hour. Interment will follow at Heritage Memorial Park.

Brenda was a native and lifelong resident of Irwinton and Milledgeville. She was the daughter of the late Lonnie Blair and Ruth Tollison. She was preceded in death by a son, Gregory Blair Mason. She is survived by her husband of 57 years, Harold Mason; son, Dell (Anne) Mason; daughter, Sharon (Dennis) Seymour; Grandchildren: Caroline Mason, Mary Kathryn (Chris) Williamson, Sarah Margaret Mason, Mason Seymour and Blair Seymour. Two sisters: Jeanie Tollison Villavicencio and Sherry Tollison Barnes. She is also survived by many brothers-in-law, sisters-in-law, nieces, and nephews.

Brenda was an active member of First United Methodist Church of Milledgeville. She graduated from GC&SU, with honors, in 1990, with a degree in Management and Marketing. She had a passion for community service which she demonstrated through her involvement with the Milledgeville Town & Country Garden Club, Civic Women's Club, Hospital Auxiliary Pink Bow Shop, and Beta Sigma Phi. She also served as past

president of the Milledgeville Country Club. She served on the foundation board at Tallulah Falls School and the Foundation and Alumni Boards of GC&SU. She helped established and operate both family businesses.

Brenda and Harold enjoyed traveling the world together but Brenda's favorite place was her porch overlooking Lake Sinclair. She also enjoyed spending time with friends in their Supper Club, Mystery Club, Spade Club and Bridge Club.

Together, Brenda and Harold, helped establish the golf program at Georgia Military College, as well as a scholarship for non-traditional students at GC&SU, since she herself had been a non-traditional student.

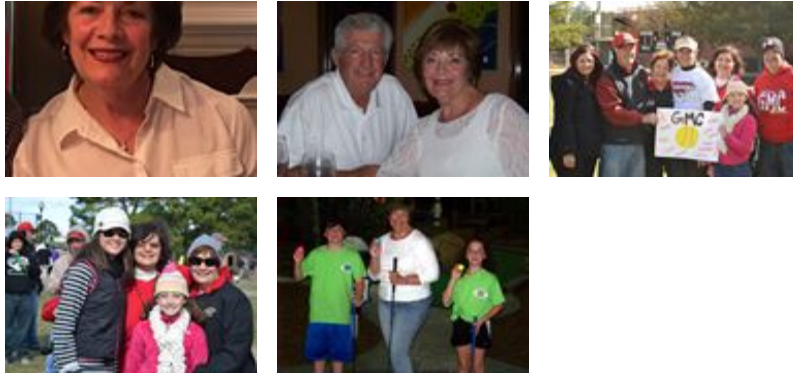
