



Bruce Lawson Allison

Mr. Bruce Lawson Allison, age 74 of Eatonton passed away peacefully at his home with his family by his side on July 4, 2018. Funeral services will be conducted at 2 pm on Sunday, July 8, 2018 in the chapel of Williams Funeral Home in Milledgeville with Rev. Paul Gardner officiating. Interment will follow in Baldwin Memorial Gardens.

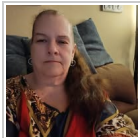
