



## Bud White

September 16, 1928 - March 11, 2016

Clarence Twitty “Bud” White, 87, died Friday, March 11 at the Georgia Veterans Retirement Home in Milledgeville, GA. Mr. White was the son of James S. White Sr. and Fay T White. Born September 16, 1928 in Greenville, Georgia, Mr. White was a graduate of Greenville High School. After attending the Georgia Institute of Technology, Mr. White enlisted in the Army and served in Korea. After leaving the service, he attended Abraham Baldwin Agricultural College where he earned an associate degree in Agriculture. Mr. White is also a graduate of the University of Georgia College of Agriculture and Environmental Sciences, receiving a Master’s degree. Mr. White worked as a county extension agent and a teacher of high school vocational agriculture. He was also employed as an account executive for IMC Rainbow Fertilizer (now Rainbow Plant Food) and Columbia Nitrogen and was active in the Lions Club.

Mr. White is survived by four children, Mindy White Serafin of Nashville, TN, Melissa White Pike of Marietta, GA, Clarence Twitty White Jr. of Warner Robins, GA, and Perry B. White of McAlester, OK; six grandchildren, and one sister Mary White Calhoun of Columbus, GA. He was preceded in death by his brother James S. (Jack) White and Robert Render (Bob) White, and his sister Elizabeth ( Bett) White Andrews.
