Mr. George Byron "Buck" Snider, Jr, age 32, passed away Sunday, June 1, 2014. Funeral services will be conducted Sunday, June 8, 2014 at 1:00pm at the Williams Funeral Home Chapel in Milledgeville, GA. Interment will follow at 4:00pm at the Mill Creek Baptist Church Cemetery in Gibson, Georgia.

The family will be at the funeral home Saturday, June 7 from 5:00pm until 7:00pm to receive friends.

Mr. Snider was a native of Milledgeville and lived there all of his life before moving to Texas 5 months ago. Mr. Snider served in the United States Marine Corps and was a veteran of the war in Afghanistan. He was a member of the Mosleyville Baptist Church.

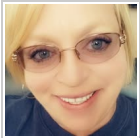

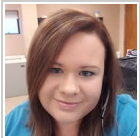

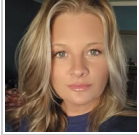
