Carol Rhodes Brookins, age 75, of Milledgeville, passed away Wednesday, June 30, 2021. Funeral services for Carol Brookins will be conducted Friday, July 2, 2021 at 11:00am in Northside Baptist Church with Dr. Jerry Pickard and Rev. David Self officiating. Interment will follow in Baldwin Memorial Gardens. The family will receive friends at the Williams Funeral Home on Thursday, July 1, 2021 from 6:00pm until 8:00pm.

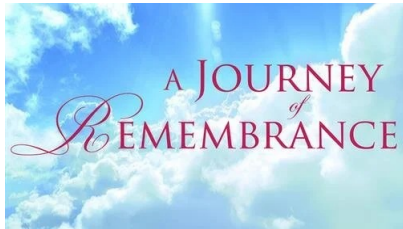

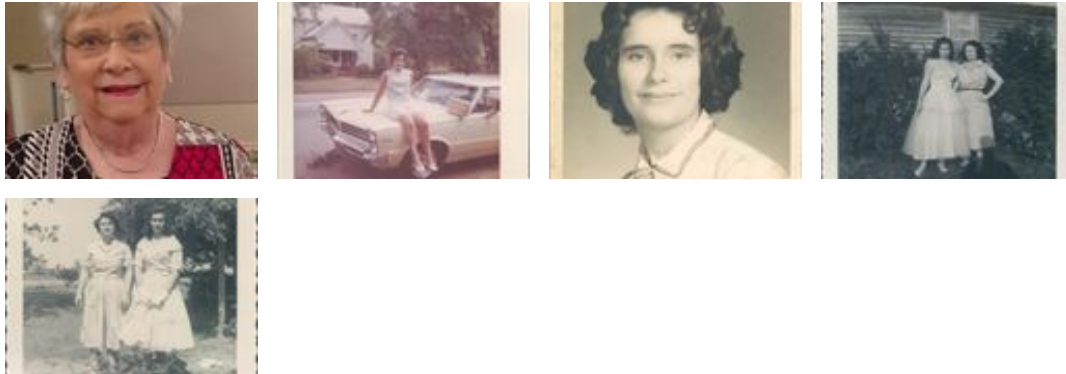
