Funeral services for Mrs. Carolyn Anglin Cooper age 90 will be private and held at Westview Cemetery in Moultrie, GA on November 4, 2020.

Mrs. Cooper passed away on November 1, 2020. She was a native of Wadley, GA and had made her home in Milledgeville since 1972.
