Audrey “Carolyn” Ferguson Smith, age 81, of Milledgeville, passed away Thursday, January 14, 2021. 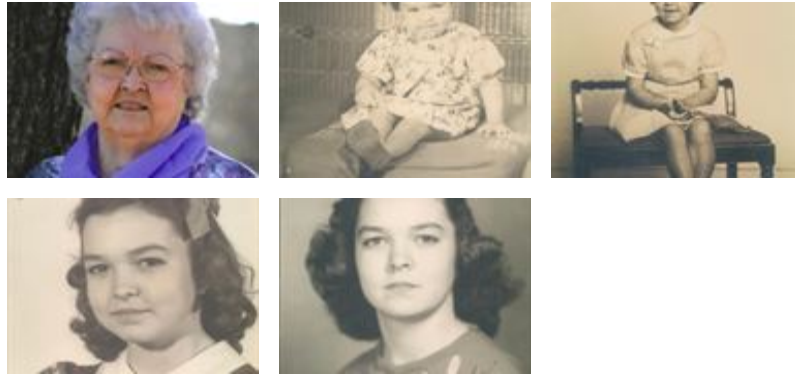
