November 19, 1932 - September 3, 2024

Mrs. Carrie George Cox, 91, surrounded by her children, went home to be with the Lord on September 3, 2024. A Funeral Service will be held on Thursday, September 5, 2024 at 3 PM in Northridge Christian Church with burial to follow in Baldwin Memorial Gardens.

The family will gather at the home of her daughter Joni Cox Smith at 153 PA Johns Road. Formal visitation with friends on Wednesday at Williams Funeral Home from 6-8PM.

Mrs. Cox was a native and lifelong resident of Milledgeville and the daughter of the late William H. George and the late Annie Hawkins George.
