Mrs. Catherine "Paps" Virginia Bacon Moodie, 89, passed away on Sunday, April 8, 2018. Funeral services will be conducted at 2 PM on Wednesday, April 11, 2018 in Irwinton Baptist Church with Rev. Gary Horton officiating. Interment will follow in Irwinton Masonic Cemetery.

The family will receive friends at the church on Wednesday from 1 PM until the service hour.

Mrs. Moodie was a native of Irwinton and lived in Coffee County before moving back to Irwinton. She was the daughter of the late Nathaniel and Elizabeth Camp Bacon; and preceded in death by her husband, Harry Goodman Moodie. She gave 50 years of service to First Baptist Church of Douglas Nursery, was a member of First Baptist Church of Irwinton, Wilkinson County Historical Society, Douglas Garden Club, and Coffee County Daughters of the American Revolution.

She is survived by her daughter, Beth (Joel) Bacon of Athens; son, Harry (Debby) Moodie of Tullahoma; grandchildren, Buck Bacon, Joel Bacon, Ginny Bacon-Talati, Ken Harbin, and 5 great grandchildren.
