Mr. Charles "Chuck" Willard Treptow, age 94, passed away November 6, 2015. A Celebration of Life will be conducted Friday, Nov. 20 at 2 p.m. at the First Presbyterian Church of Milledgeville, 210 South Wayne St. Reverend Susan Balfour and Rev. John Lansma will officiate.
