Charlie Monroe Edinfield, Jr., age 81, passed away Saturday, March 28, 2020. Funeral Services for Charlie Edinfield, Jr. will be conducted from the Graveside on Monday, March 30, 2020 at 2:00 pm in Heritage Memorial Park with Rev. Tim Oliver officiating.

A native of Putnam County, Charlie was born on July 22, 1938 to the late Charlie Monroe Edinfield, Sr. and the late Fannie Clyde Moon Edinfield. 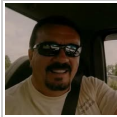
