



Constance Butts

December 27, 1935 - September 12, 2007

Mrs. C.O. Brown-Butts was a life-long resident of Baldwin County who after a distinguished legal career in Illinois, returned home to care for her parents, Retired County Extension Agent, the late Mr. C.O. Brown and Retired School Teacher and First inductee in the Teacher's Hall of Fame, Mrs. Floria D. Brown. Initially employed by the Justice Dept, Mrs. Butts was selected to become the Coordinator of the Neighborhood Youth Corps, a pilot job training and placement program for high school dropouts. She was the first Female Police Officer on the Milledgeville Police Force and the first female graduate of the Georgia Police Academy. She later worked for the Labor Department until retirement, but then spent several years working as a substitute teacher for the Baldwin County School System. Mrs. Butts was a long time member of St. Stephen's Episcopal Church and was active in several civic and political organizations.

She is survived by her husband, Mr. LeRoy Butts, Sr. and her children, Mr. Charles (Chase Allen) Covington (and wife, Mrs. Marti Covington), Mr. LeRoy (Rocky) Butts, Jr., Ms. Ramona Dugger, Mr. Keith M. Browning, Ms. Amy K. Faulkner, Ms. Pamela Butts, Mr. Walstene Butts, Ms. Katrina Driskell, and Mr. Steve Rudd. Grandchildren: Ms. Desiree Dugger, Tyler Butts and Jamia Butts. She's also survived by her mother-in-law, Mrs. Lula Gay Butts, a brother in law, Mr. J.W. Butts; and sisters-in-law, Mrs. Danya Butts and Mrs. Bernice Butts.

Services for Mrs. Butts will be held at Williams Funeral Home on Jefferson Street, Friday afternoon at 4:00 p.m. Internment will follow in Memory Hill Cemetery. The family will receive friends at the family home, 544 Boundary Street.
