Curtis David Douglas, age 79, of Milledgeville, passed away Wednesday, October 6, 2021. A Celebration of Life will take place at the family's residence on Saturday, October 16, 2021 at 10:00am with Rev. Sam Halverson, and Pastor and friend, Esther Lanting officiating. The family will visit with friends at their residence, after the service. Burial will take place at 3 pm in Rose Hill Cemetery, in Alma, Georgia.
