



Curtis Tubb

December 17, 1937 - September 11, 2016

Mr. William “Curtis” Tubb died Sunday, September 11th, 2016 after a brief illness at age 78. He was preceded in death by his parents, Rev. Loyd Washigton Tubb and Frances “Evelyn” Bryan Tubb of Alabama, and his brother Loyd Bryan Tubb of Cherry Hill, New Jersey.

Curtis was born in Louisville, Alabama and as a preacher’s son spent his early years moving to different parts of northwest Florida and southeast Alabama. He quickly picked up the knack of making friends quickly and kept that skill for the rest of his life. He spent much of his adult life in Milledgeville.

Curtis loved the outdoors and spent many hours camping, hiking, and fishing. The past few years he carried on that love by gardening, and tending his birdfeeders and violets at the nursing home where he resided. He also enjoyed cheering for his Florida State Seminoles.

He was a graduate of Huntington University in Alabama, and served briefly as a Methodist minister before moving to a different calling. He also served in the U.S. Army and was a veteran of the Berlin Crisis. He received a Master’s degree in Vocational Rehabilitation from Florida State University and worked in Juvenile Justice for a number of years before moving into Real Estate. He spent more than 20 years as the Broker at Lakeside Realty in Milledgeville.

He is survived by his son, Raymond Tubb (Valerie) and grandson Nick Tubb of Macon, Georgia, and daughter Michelle Dixon (Joseph) of Milledgeville.

There will be a visitation on Friday, September 16th at 4:30 p.m. followed by a memorial service at 5 p.m. at Williams Funeral Home in Milledgeville. Family members will greet friends before and after the service.

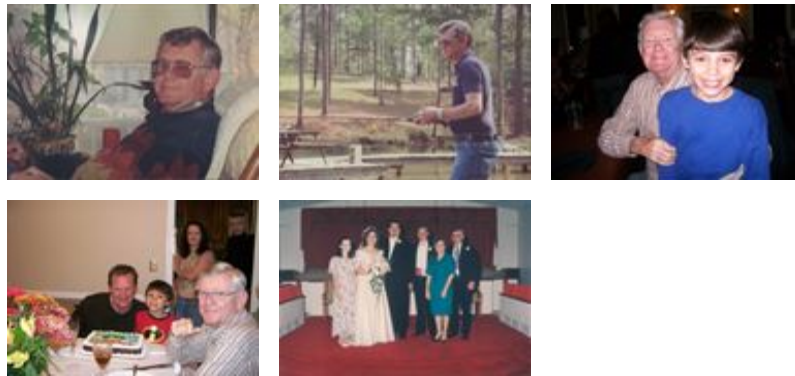
