

## David Hall Howington

May 14, 1947 - September 5, 2016

Funeral services for Mr. David Hall Howington, age 69, will be conducted Saturday, September 10, 2016, at 2:00 pm at First United Methodist Church in Milledgeville, GA, with Mr. Charlie Dewey Howington officiating. There will be a visitation prior to the service beginning at 1:00 p.m. at First United Methodist Church.

David passed away Monday, September 5, 2016. He graduated from Wrightsville High School, Class of 1966. He enlisted into the Armed Forces August 31, 1966, and honorably served a tour of duty in the Vietnam War until he was discharged on August 24, 1969. He received the National Defense Service Medal, Vietnam Service Medal, Vietnam Campaign Medal, Air Medal, Army Commendation, Good Conduct Medal, and a Purple Heart. He then returned home and married his high school sweetheart, Kathie Janet Robinson. David and Kathie raised their two boys, Chan and Chris, in Macon, GA. David then moved to Milledgeville, GA in 2012 to be with his children and grandchildren.

David Howington was preceded in death by his parents, George David Howington and Frankie Hall Howington; and Kathie Robinson Howington, his wife. He is survived by his two sons, Chan Howington (Rebecca), Chris Howington; granddaughters, Maggie, Becca, Ella and Martha, daughters of Chan Howington; brothers, Dewey Howington (Kyle), Billy Mike Howington

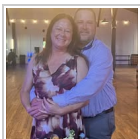
