Rev. David Allen Self, 63, passed away on Saturday, September 4, 2021. Funeral services will be held at 11 AM on Saturday, September 11, 2021 in Victory Baptist Church with Rev. Tim Oliver and Rev. Terry Cliett officiating.

Graveside services will be held at 3 PM in Macon Memorial Park.

The family will receive friends from 4 PM until 6 PM on Friday, September 10, 2021 in Lakeside Baptist Church.

Rev. David Self was a native of Macon, Georgia. He was the son of the late Jessie Lee and Mary Annie Redden Self. He earned his Bachelors Degree in Christianity from Mercer University and a Masters of Divinity from The Southern Baptist Theological Seminary in Louisville, KY. He served at Houston Heights Baptist Church in Macon before moving to Milledgeville and becoming the Director of Missions at Washington Baptist Association where he has served for the last 22 years. He is a member of Lakeside Baptist Church.

He is survived by his wife, Kathy Self of Milledegville; daughter, Kelly Carter (Justin) of Marietta; son, Jonathan David Self (Chrissy)of Warner Robins; and sisters, Eileen Self of Cochran, and Joyce Knowles (Freddie) of Woodstock.
