David fell ill in 2020 and lost mobility after many back surgeries. He could not do his many activities he loved so much, so his passion turned to writing poetry in the nursing home and would give his work to all he met. He resided with his brothers in arms at the Georgia War Veterans Home in Milledgeville, GA. until his death on August 28, 2024. David was a fighter even through the years of pain.
