Mr. Don "Donnie" B. Mays, III, age 39, passed away Sunday, February 2, 2014. Funeral Services will be conducted Thursday, February 6, 2014 at 11AM in Davisboro Baptist Church. Interment will follow at 3PM in Lakeview Memorial Gardens in Vidalia, GA.
