Funeral services for Doris "Dot" Bayne Weaver Stevens who passed away at age 94 on Aug. 14, 2016, will be conducted Tuesday, August 16, 2016, at 2 pm in Williams Funeral Home Chapel in Milledgeville with Dr. Jerry Pickard officiating. Interment will be private.

The family will receive friends at the Funeral Home on Tuesday from 1 pm until the service hour.

Mrs. Stevens was born in Atlanta, Georgia, but made her home in Milledgeville.

In 1968, she was widowed by her first husband, U.S. Army Chief Warrant Officer William T. Weaver, the father of her three children. She is also predeceased by her second husband, David Stevens, and children, William Bayne Weaver, and Virginia Frances Smith.

Although her hometown was Milledgeville, as an Army wife she also lived in Maryland, Virginia and Italy. Dot, as she was often called, was there with a sympathetic ear - and often with delicious Southern cooking - when someone needed her. She was much loved for her kindness and generosity to others, who also enjoyed her quick wit.

She was fortunately blessed with a very sharp mind, even to the end of her life.

She was an amazing woman with a feisty spirit who recovered from two

crippling surgeries and several serious illnesses.

Though she was a full-time mother much of her life, she also worked in various industry jobs and as a counselor. Doris, (Mama) will be greatly missed. Her latter years were spent at Green Acres Nursing Home, where she received excellent care. The family would especially like to thank the nurses and other staff there, who lovingly and patiently cared for her though she insisted on being as independent as she could, often to the frustration of the family and others! But she was admired for this fighting spirit.

She is survived by her daughter, Carol Weaver Hallisey and husband Joel of Stockbridge; brother, Ernest E. Bayne and wife Anne Pittman Bayne of Milledgeville; son-in-law, Sam Smith and daughter-in-law, Susan Weaver; grandchildren, great grandchildren, nieces and nephews.
