Douglas Landrum, age 82, of Milledgeville, passed away Saturday, September 27, 2025. 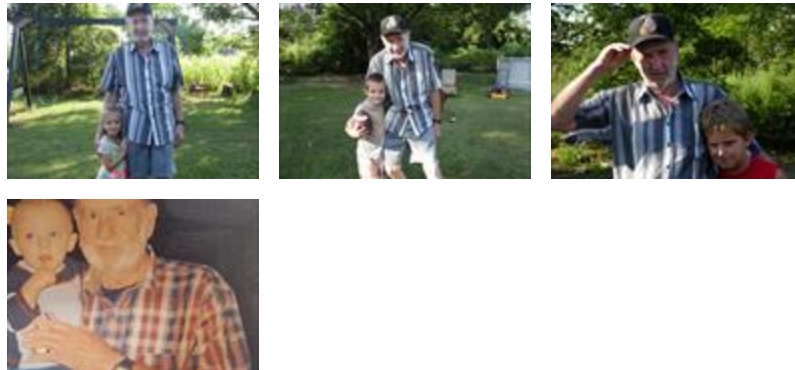

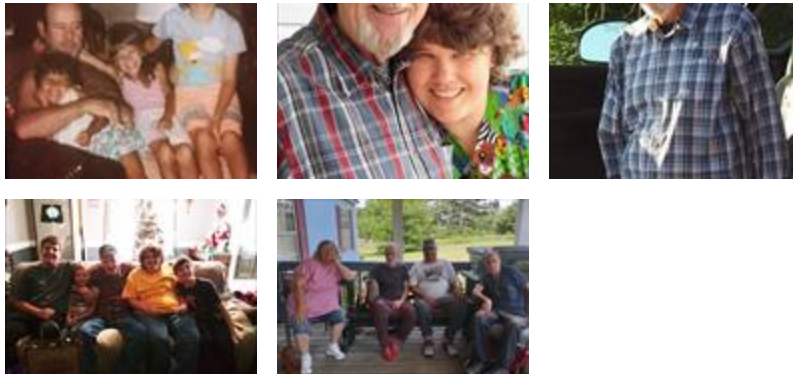
