



Dr. Dorothy Sallis Stewart

September 11, 1954 - October 24, 2022

Dr. Dorothy Sallis Stewart, age 68, of Milledgeville, passed away Monday, October 24, 2022. Funeral services for Dr. Dorothy Sallis Stewart will be conducted Saturday, October 29, 2022 at 2:00pm in the Chapel of Williams Funeral Home with Rev. Edward Allen officiating. Interment will follow in Heritage Memorial Park. The family will receive friends at the Williams Funeral Home on Friday, October 28, 2022 from 5:00pm – 7:00pm.

A native of Sallis, MS, Dr. Stewart was born on September 11, 1954 to the late John Henry Sallis and the late Lillie Mae Ward Sallis. Dorothy was also preceded in death by a sister, Mattie Hightower, and by a brother, John Henry Sallis, Jr..

Dr. Stewart received her Medical Doctorate from Wright State University. She earned her Undergraduate Degree at Tougaloo College in Tougaloo, MS, and completed a Fellowship at the University of California - San Diego. She came to Milledgeville in 1998 to begin her medical practice. She later worked with the Georgia War Veterans Home, as Medical Director. Dr. Stewart was a member of the Zion Church of God in Christ, and a member of Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Inc..

Dr. Stewart is survived by her husband, Douglas Stewart of Milledgeville ; her daughter, Lillian Stewart of Dallas, TX ; her son, Douglas Stewart, II of Atlanta ; her step-daughter, Tameka Hardy of Detroit, MI ; her sisters, Clara Jackson

of Waterloo, Iowa, Lucille (& Willie) Hutchinson of Sallis, MS, Rita (& Joe) Roby of Rockford, IL, Sarah Greer of Waterloo, Iowa, Lillie Dickens of Gulfport, MS, Evon Sallis of Waterloo, Iowa, and Mamie Crawford of Detroit, MI ; her brothers, McArthur (& Mary) Sallis of Sallis, MS, Richard Sallis of Waterloo, Iowa, and Otha Sallis of Gulf Port, MS.

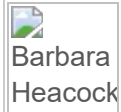
