Mr. Earnest Lawrence Haislip, age 84, passed away Friday, July 22, 2011. Funeral Services will be conducted Monday, July 25, 2011 at 1PM in Georgia Veteran's Memorial Cemetery with Rev. Morris Wood officiating. A procession will leave Williams Funeral Home Monday at 12 Noon.

The family will be at Williams Funeral Home of Milledgeville Sunday, July 24, 2011 from 3-5PM to receive friends.
