Mr. Edward L. "Bo" Sibilsky, Jr., age 72, passed away Tuesday, February 5, 2013.

Memorial Services will be conducted Saturday, March 16, 2013 at 2pm in the First Presbyterian Church of Milledgeville with Rev. Debbie Osterhoudt officiating. The family will receive friends after the service in the fellowship hall.

Mr. Sibilsky was a native of Milledgeville and had lived most of his adult life in Baldwin County. He was the son of the late Edward Louis Sibilsky, Sr. and Ethlyn Baston Sibilsky. Bo graduated from Georgia Southern University, was a member of the First Presbyterian Church and was Owner and Broker for Sibilsky Realty for many years.
