Edward "Ed" Wood, 74, of Gordon, Ga, passed away Monday, May 21, 2007. Son of the late Osler G and Stella Smith Wood, he was born in Montgomery County, but had lived in Gordon for the past 19 years. Mr. Wood was a member of the Masonic Aural Lodge 239 and VFW Post 10229, and former member of the Lions Club and Rotary Club. He was a veteran of the United States Army, having served during the Korean Conflict. Mr. Wood was retired from Georgia Power after 34 years of service and a member and deacon of the Gordon First Baptist Church. He was preceded in death by his first wife, Ruth C.
