July 1, 1944 - January 8, 2024

Mrs. Eloise Beckum Stubbs, age 79 passed away on January 8, 2024, after an extended illness. 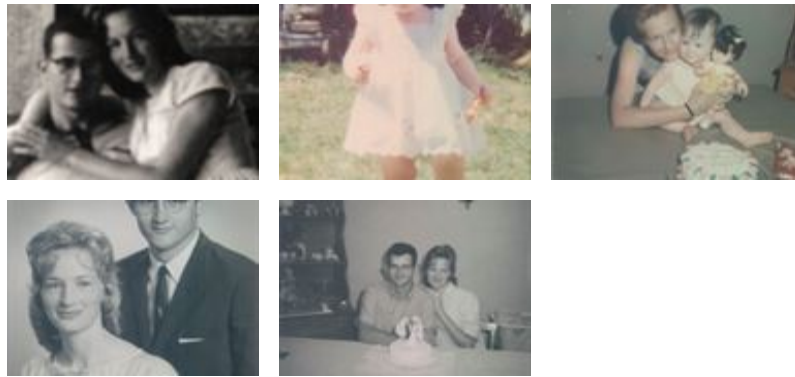
