Mr. Emerson O. Whipple, age 94, passed away Wednesday, March 10, 2010. Funeral Services will be held Sunday, March 14, 2010 Graveside in Baldwin Memorial Gardens with Rev. Tim Oliver officiating.

The Family will receive friends at Williams Funeral Home Sunday from 1:30PM until the service hour.

Mr. Whipple was born in Ledyard, Conn., the son of the late Emerson and Nora Massey Whipple. He was preceded in death by his sisters Mildred Rand and Dorothy Loftus. He had been a resident of Georgia since 1987. He was a graduate of the Robert E. Fitch H.S. in Groton, Conn., attended Mitchell College, and completed a course in piano tuning and repair at the Pierce School of Piano Technology in Boston, Mass. He was the former owner of the Whipple Piano and Organ Co. in Groton, Conn. for twenty years. Mr. Whipple was a U.S. Navy Veteran of World War II, serving as a Yeoman 2nd class at a Navy air facility in Brazil. He was a member of the Friendship Bible Chapel in Eatonton. A violinist, he played in a number of churches in the area. He was a dedicated Christian, and a student of Bible prophecy.
