Eugenia Thomas English, 81, formerly of Milledgeville GA, passed away April 20, 2022, at Northside Forsyth Hospital in Cumming, GA.

Eugenia was born May 17, 1940, in Stuart Florida, to the late Reverend L.E. and Annie Willie Thomas. She grew up in Bennettsville SC, where her father was the minister of Thomas Memorial Baptist Church. After graduating high school in 1958, she attended the Georgia Baptist School of Nursing, where she earned her nursing degree in 1961. She married the late Thad Patrick (Pat) English in 1962, and they made their home in Milledgeville.

While working, Eugenia decided to further her education, and enrolled at The Medical College of Georgia, where she graduated with her Bachelor of Science in Nursing in 1976. She devoted many years to caring for others and retired from Central State Hospital in 1996. After retirement, she enjoyed traveling, spending time at the lake, and being “Nana” to her grandchildren. She was a devout Christian lady and was an active member of Hardwick Baptist Church. One of her most cherished memories was serving on a mission trip to Ghana, Africa.

Eugenia is survived by her son, Thad Patrick English, Jr. (Kathy) of Cumming, GA ; by her daughter, Anne English Lee (Carlo) of Perry GA, her grandchildren, Anna Parrish English and Kathryn Elizabeth English of

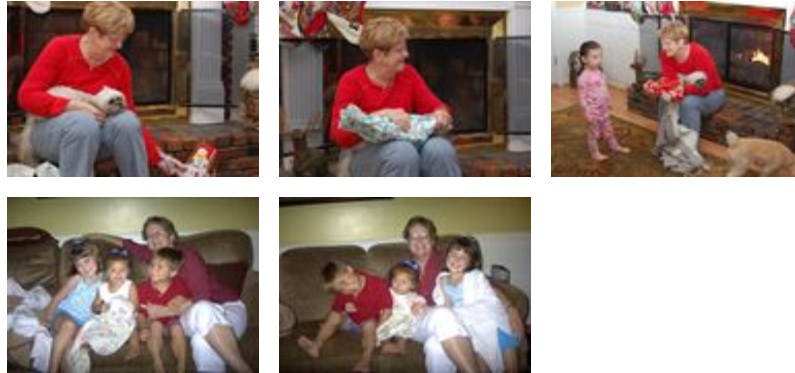
