November 12, 1916 - October 26, 2016

Dr. Henrietta Floride Moore Gardner, 99, passed away Wednesday, October 26, 2016, a visitation will be held Friday, October 28, 2016 from 4 to 6PM at Williams in Milledgeville. A private Graveside service will be held Saturday. A Celebration of Life will be held November 12, 2016 at First United Methodist, from 2-4PM. Dr. Gardner received her Masters Degree from the University of Tennessee and received her Doctorate from NYU. She taught college at Columbia, University of AL, and the University of GA; she came back to finish her career at GCSU, where she retired. She was a member of D.A.R. and the First United Methodist Church.

Mrs. Gardner is preceded in death by her parents, Charles Leighton Moore and May Temperance Allen Moore, her husband, Paul Eugene Gardner.
