



Frank Edward Campbell Sr.

April 3, 1921 - February 20, 2009

Funeral Mass for Mr. Frank E. Campbell, Sr. Age 87, will be celebrated, Tuesday Morning, 10 am in the Sacred Heart Catholic Church with Msgr. Frank Mahler as celebrant. Interment will follow at 2:30 pm. At the Andersonville National Cemetery. Visitation will be held at Sacred Heart Catholic Church, Monday Evening from 5 until 6 with a Rosary Service at 6 PM.

Mr. Campbell was a native of New York, New York. He was the son of the late Joseph Patrick Campbell and the late Christina Mahler Campbell. He was a Veteran of World War II, having served in the United States Army Air Corp. After the War, Mr. Campbell began a career with Grumman Aerospace Corp. In Bethpage, New York. He was on the original team of employees transferred to begin the Milledgeville Grumman plant in 1975; retiring from the company in 1984. Mr. Campbell was the widower of Mrs. Constance Rose Southwick Campbell. He was a member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church and the Grumman Retirees Club. Mr. Campbell was a volunteer at Central State Hospital, Meals on Wheels and the LDS Family Research Center.

Survivors include his son, Frank Campbell of Milledgeville.
