Mr. Frederick Alex Myrick, Sr., age 73, of Thomaston, died Saturday, June 1, 2024, at Brightmoor Hospice in Griffin, GA.

Mr. Myrick was born in Savannah, GA, on August 3, 1950, to the late Melvin Lee Myrick and the late Frances Kicklighter Myrick. He was a 1968 graduate of Baldwin High School in Milledgeville, GA.
