Frederick "Fredrick" Riley Gleason, age 19, passed away May 21, 2012. A service to honor him will be held Wednesday, May 30, 2012 at 10:30 AM at the First Presbyterian Church of Milledgeville with Rev. Debbie Osterhoudt officiating.

Mr. Gleason was a proud native of Ellensburg, Washington and had moved to Milledgeville in 2003 at the age of 10. 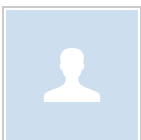
