Mr. Fredrick William Hammerschmidt, age 77, passed away on December 25, 2019. Services will be conducted Monday, December 30, 2019 at 3 P.M. in Williams Funeral Home Chapel.

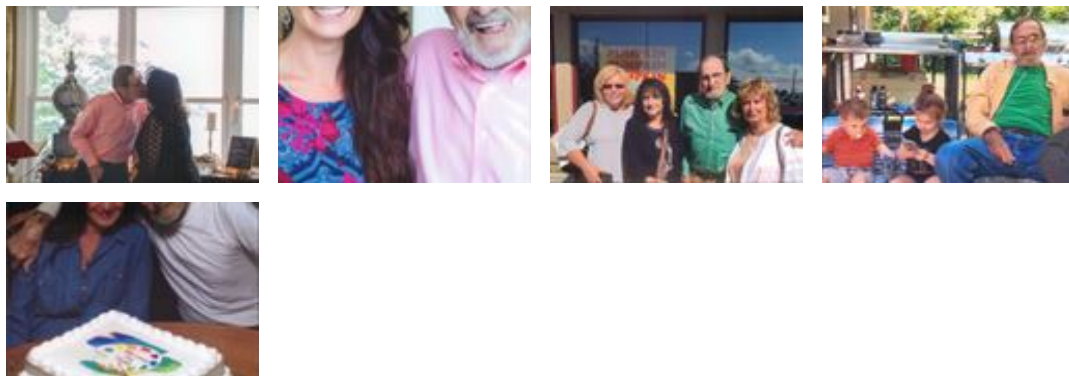
