April 25, 1924 - May 11, 2009

Fretta Wells Trotter, 85, of Milledgeville, Georgia, died Monday, May 11, 2009 in Augusta after a brief illness.

She was a native of Anderson, South Carolina and has lived in Milledgeville since 1953. She was preceded in death by her husband, John D. Trotter, and she was the last surviving sibling of eight children of Bert and Sara Wells, also deceased.

She was an active member of Sinclair Baptist Church for many years. She was a devoted Mother and lifelong homemaker.
