Mr. Garrison D. Loudermilk, age 86, passed away Friday, August 26, 2011. Funeral Services will be conducted, Wednesday, August 31 at 1PM in Williams Funeral Home Chapel of Eatonton with Rev. Keithen Tucker officiating. Interment will follow in Eatonton Memorial Park.
