



## George Dyll

February 1, 1941 - June 13, 2013

George Dyll, age 72, passed away at his home on Lake Sinclair, Eatonton, Georgia on June 13, 2013. He is survived by his wife Jackie, his sons Tom and Mike Dyll. Others include his daughter-in-law Dr. Shellie Campbell and three grandchildren, Cameron, Erika and Tommy, his sister Erika Appel and nephew Christopf Reichert both of Germany.

Mr. Dyll is preceded in death by his mother Sophie (Heise) Lorenz and father Robert Dyll also in Germany.

George was born in Tulchau, West Prussia Germany February 1, 1941.

His life is best described as the quintessential American dream. Arriving in Canada June 26, 1963 from Germany at age 22 with his journeyman papers stating he had completed his Journeymen's Examination Board of Motor mechanics Guild held at Darmstadt, Germany on October 29, 1959. In 1964 he was a member of the Automobile Mechanics Local of Chicago Illinois. He was drafted December 8, 1964 and served in the United States Army, in the 101st Airborne Quarter Master Company. His service was completed May 19, 1971 with an honorable discharge.

George met and married Jacqueline Gleitsman May 30, 1968 in Chicago, Illinois.

Mr. Dyll attained his US citizenship in 1973. Mr. Dyll worked for Ford Motor Company, and Detroit Diesel Allison before partnering and owning a Ford Truck Dealership in Ft. Lauderdale Fl.

After retirement Mr. Dyll pursued his passion for Trap Shooting, fishing and hunting.

Cremation rites have been accorded. Private family services will be held at Honey Creek Woods in Conyers Georgia.
