Mr. George R. Hart, age 96, passed away on June 18, 2015. A memorial service will be held on Thursday, June 25, 2015, at St. Stephen's Episcopal Church with The Reverend David Probst officiating.

Mr. Hart was a native of Lenoir, N.C. and had made his home in Milledgeville since 1962. He was the son of the late George R. Hart and Mattie Norris Hart. Mr. Hart had retired as an administrator from Central State Hospital and was a veteran of the United States Navy, having served during WWII in the Pacific and later in the Naval Air Reserve. He was a past member of Rotary, Kiwanis, and L.I.R. and was an avid golfer. He was a member of St. Stephen's Episcopal Church and served the parish as senior warden several times.

Mr. Hart is survived by his wife, Ruth Beach Hart of Milledgeville and daughters Carol McLaughlin of Milledgeville and Stuart, FL. and Jane M. Hart of Milledgeville, as well as several nieces and nephews.

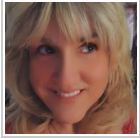
