Mr. George Clark Thompson, 77, passed away on Friday, April 7, 2017. Funeral services will be conducted on Wednesday, April 12, 2017 at 11:00 AM in the Chapel of Williams Funeral Home of Milledgeville with Rev. Jay Tucker officiating. Interment will be held at Georgia Veterans Memorial Cemetery at 1 PM.
